- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2154.202(g), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (g) Except as provided by Subsection (h), a retail fireworks
- 8 permit holder may sell fireworks only to the public, and only during
- 9 periods:

- 10 (1) beginning June 24 and ending at midnight on July 4;
- 11 (2) beginning December 20 and ending at midnight on
- 12 January 1 of the following year; [and]
- 13 (3) beginning May 1 and ending at midnight on May 5 if
- 14 the fireworks are sold at a location that is not more than 100 miles
- 15 from the Texas-Mexico border and that is in a county in which the
- 16 commissioners court of the county has approved the sale of
- 17 fireworks during the period; and
- 18 (4) beginning five days before Lunar New Year and
- 19 ending at midnight on Lunar New Year in a county in which the
- 20 commissioners court of the county has approved the sale of
- 21 fireworks during the period.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
