A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the sale of fireworks on and before the Lunar New Year 3 holiday. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 2154.202, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Subsection (g) (4) to read as follows: 6 (g) Except as provided by Subsection (h), a retail fireworks 7 permit holder may sell fireworks only to the public, and only during 8 9 periods: beginning June 24 and ending at midnight on July 4; 10 (1)11 (2) beginning December 20 and ending at midnight on January 12 1 of the following year; and beginning May 1 and ending at midnight on May 5 if the 13 (3) fireworks are sold at a location that is not more than 100 miles 14 from the Texas-Mexico border and that is in a county in which the 15 commissioners court of the county has approved the sale of 16 fireworks during the period. 17 (4) beginning five days before Lunar New Year and ending at 18 midnight on Lunar New Year. 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025. 20
