relating to the sale of fireworks on and before the Lunar New Year 1-17 1-18 holiday.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 2154.202(g), Occupations amended to read as follows:

- (g) Except as provided by Subsection (h), a retail fireworks permit holder may sell fireworks only to the public, and only during periods:
 - (1)beginning June 24 and ending at midnight on July 4; beginning December 20 and ending at midnight on (2)

- January 1 of the following year; [and]
 (3) beginning May 1 and ending at midnight on May 5 if the fireworks are sold at a location that is not more than 100 miles from the Texas-Mexico border and that is in a county in which the commissioners court of the county has approved the sale of fireworks during the period; and
- 1-33 (4) beginning five days before Lunar New Year ending at midnight on Lunar New Year in a county in which the 1-34 1-35 commissioners court of the county has approved the sale of fireworks during the period.

 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025. 1-36
