A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the regulation of used and scrap tires by certain
3	counties.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 361, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 361.1121 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 361.1121. MARKING USED OR SCRAP TIRES IN CERTAIN
8	COUNTIES. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Generator" includes a fleet operator, a tire
10	recapper or retreader, or a retailer, wholesaler, or manufacturer
11	of whole new or used tires. The term does not include a scrap tire
12	energy recovery facility or a scrap tire recycling facility.
13	(2) "Retailer" means a person who is engaged in the
14	business of selling or otherwise placing tires in the stream of
15	commerce for use on a vehicle, trailer, or piece of equipment.
16	(3) "Scrap tire" has the meaning assigned by Section
17	361.112. The term does not include a tire:
18	(A) in or on a vehicle that:
19	(i) has been crushed; or
20	(ii) is being transported to a registered
21	metal recycling entity or a licensed used automotive parts
22	recycler; or
23	(B) that is mounted on a metal wheel that is
24	intended to be recycled.

1	(4) "Used tire" means a tire that:
2	(A) has been used as a tire on a vehicle, trailer,
3	or piece of equipment;
4	(B) has tire tread at least one-sixteenth inch
5	deep;
6	(C) can still be used for its original intended
7	purpose; and
8	(D) meets the visual and tread depth requirements
9	for used tires established by the Department of Public Safety.
10	(b) This section applies only to a county with a population
11	<u>of 150,000 or less.</u>
12	(c) The commissioners court of a county to which this
13	section applies may establish and enforce a program requiring a
14	generator to mark used or scrap tires handled by the generator.
15	(d) A program established under this section must:
16	(1) assign to each generator a unique identifying mark
17	required to be affixed to or imprinted on each scrap or used tire
18	taken possession of or produced by the generator;
19	(2) allow a customer to retain a scrap or used tire
20	removed from the customer's vehicle during the purchase of a tire
21	<pre>from a retailer;</pre>
22	(3) require a retailer whose customer retains a scrap
23	or used tire to keep a record of the customer's retention; and
24	(4) include a system to inspect generators for
25	compliance.
26	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
