- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 13.103, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 13.103. INITIATION OF DETACHMENT. (a) Creation of a
- 8 new district by detachment of territory that is in a single county
- 9 is initiated by a petition presented to the district court for the
- 10 county. The petition is subject to Subsection (c), but is not
- 11 subject to the requirements of law or court rule for a petition
- 12 initiating a civil suit.
- 13 <u>(b)</u> Creation of a new district by detachment of territory
- 14 that is in more than one county is initiated by resolution of the
- 15 board of trustees of each district from which territory is to be
- 16 detached or by a petition presented to the commissioners court.
- 17 (c) A petition under this subchapter must:
- 18 (1) give the metes and bounds of the proposed new
- 19 district;
- 20 (2) be signed by at least 20 [10] percent of the
- 21 registered voters residing in each [the proposed area to be
- 22 detached from an] existing district from which territory is to be
- 23 detached; [and]

- 1 (A) the <u>district</u> [commissioners] court <u>for</u> [of]
- 2 the county in which the territory of the proposed district is
- 3 located; or $[\tau]$
- 4 (B) if the territory is in more than one county,
- 5 to the commissioners court of each county in which the territory is
- 6 located.
- 7 SECTION 2. Sections 13.104(a) and (d), Education Code, are
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 13.104. ELECTION. (a) Not later than the 30th day
- 10 after the date \underline{a} [the commissioners] court receives a petition
- 11 under this subchapter, the [commissioners] court shall hold a
- 12 hearing on the validity of the petition. If the [commissioners]
- 13 court determines the petition is valid, each board of trustees
- 14 shall order an election to be held on the same date in each
- 15 district.
- 16 (d) The boards of trustees shall report the results of the
- 17 election to the appropriate court or [commissioners] courts, which
- 18 shall declare the results of the election. The new school district
- 19 is created only if the proposition receives:
- 20 (1) a majority of the votes in the territory to be
- 21 detached; and
- 22 (2) a majority of the votes in the remaining territory
- 23 in each district from which property is to be detached in the manner
- 24 prescribed by Section 13.003.
- 25 SECTION 3. Section 13.105, Education Code, is amended to
- 26 read as follows:
- Sec. 13.105. CREATION OF DISTRICT. (a) If all the

- 1 requirements of this subchapter are met, the appropriate
- 2 [commissioners] court shall enter an order creating the new school
- 3 district. If the new district contains territory in two or more
- 4 counties, the order must be concurred in by the commissioners court
- 5 of each county concerned.
- 6 (b) At the time the order creating the district is made, the
- 7 district court or the commissioners court of the county in which the
- 8 largest portion of the district's territory is located, as
- 9 appropriate, shall appoint a board of seven trustees for the new
- 10 district to serve until the next regular election of trustees, when
- 11 a board of trustees shall be elected in compliance with Chapter 11.
- 12 (c) Title to school district real property in the territory
- 13 detached vests in the new district. The new district assumes and is
- 14 liable for any portion of outstanding indebtedness of the district
- 15 from which the territory was detached that is allocated to the new
- 16 district under Section 13.004, except that the district court shall
- 17 make the required allocations under that section for a district
- 18 created in a single county.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
