A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 552.11765, Government Code, is amended
- 7 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (b) Except as provided by Subsections (c), (c-1), and (d),
- 10 information maintained by a governmental body described by Section
- 11 552.003(1)(A)(i) is confidential and excepted from the
- 12 requirements of Section 552.021 if the information:
- 13 (1) is a license application; or
- 14 (2) relates to the home address, home telephone
- 15 number, electronic mail address, social security number, date of
- 16 birth, driver's license number, state identification number,
- 17 passport number, emergency contact information, or payment
- 18 information of:
- 19 (A) an applicant for a license issued by the
- 20 governmental body;
- 21 (B) an individual who holds a license issued by
- 22 the governmental body; or
- (C) an individual who previously held a license
- 24 issued by the governmental body.

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- 1 (c-1) Subsection (b) does not prohibit the secretary of
- 2 state from disclosing the home address, home telephone number, or
- 3 <u>electronic mail address of a notary public appointed under</u>
- 4 Subchapter A, Chapter 406.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
