- 9 (b) Section 51.9317(c), Education Code, as added by this
- 10 Act, applies beginning with money appropriated to a public
- 11 institution of higher education for a state fiscal year beginning
- 12 September 1, 2026.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
