BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

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This Act may be cited as the Right to Privacy 1-24 SECTION 1. 1-25 Act.

1-26 SECTION 2. The heading to Chapter 2062, Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-27 1-28

CHAPTER 2062. RESTRICTIONS ON STATE AGENCY USE AND DISSEMINATION OF CERTAIN PERSONAL [INDIVIDUAL-IDENTIFYING] INFORMATION

1-30 SECTION 3. Section 2062.001, Government Code, is amended by 1-31 amending Subdivision (2) and adding Subdivision (3) to read as 1-32 follows:

1-33 "Personal identifying information" includes (2)а person's home address, home telephone number, personal cell phone number, personal e-mail address, driver's license number, 1-34 1-35 emergency contact information, and information that reveals whether a person has family members. (3) "State agency" means a department, commission, 1-36 reveals 1-37

(3) "State agency" means a department, commission, board, office, council, authority, or other agency in the executive, legislative, or judicial branch of state government, 1-38 1-39 1-40 including a university system or institution of higher education as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code, that is created by the 1-41 1-42 constitution or a statute of this state. 1-43

1 - 44SECTION 4. Chapter 2062, Government Code, is amended by 1-45 adding Section 2062.003 to read as follows:

Sec. 2062.003. CONSENT REQUIRED BEFORE DISSEMINATING CERTAIN PERSONAL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION; RECORDS. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a state agency may not, without written 1-46 1-47 1-48 1-49 consent, disseminate to any person the personal identifying 1-50 information of a person who submits information to the state agency 1-51 for the purpose of obtaining an occupational license.

(b) A state agency may disseminate information described by Subsection (a) with respect to a person without the person's 1-52 1-53 1-54 written consent if the dissemination is:

1-55 (1) required or permitted by a federal statute or by 1-56 another law of this state; or

1-57 (2) made by or to a law enforcement agency for a law enforcement purpose. 1-58

1-59 (c) A state agency shall retain the written consent of a 1-60 person obtained as required under this section in the state agency's records. 1-61

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(d) For purposes of this section, the term "occupational license" does not include a license or permit that is administered 2-1 2-2 by the comptroller under the Occupations Code. 2-3

2-4 SECTION 5. Section 2062.003, Government Code, as added by 2**-**5 2**-**6 this Act, applies only to information disseminated or retained by a

state agency on or after the effective date of this Act. SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 2-7 2-8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 2-9 2-10 2-11 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
