- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 658.001, Government Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Subdivision (3) to read as follows:
- 6 (3) "Telework" means a work arrangement that allows an
- 7 employee of a state agency to conduct on a regular basis all or some
- 8 agency business at a place other than the employee's regular or
- 9 assigned temporary place of employment during all or a portion of
- 10 the employee's established work hours.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 658.010(a), Government Code, is amended
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 (a) An employee of a state agency shall, during normal
- 14 office hours, conduct agency business only at the employee's
- 15 regular or assigned temporary place of employment unless the
- 16 employee:
- 17 (1) is travelling; or
- 18 (2) <u>has received authorization to telework under</u>
- 19 Section 658.011 [received prior written authorization from the
- 20 administrative head of the employing state agency to perform work
- 21 elsewhere].
- 22 SECTION 3. Chapter 658, Government Code, is amended by
- 23 adding Sections 658.011 and 658.012 to read as follows:
- Sec. 658.011. AUTHORIZATION OF TELEWORK. (a) The

- 1 administrative head of a state agency may enter into an agreement
- 2 with an employee authorizing telework in order to:
- 3 (1) address a lack of available office space for the
- 4 agency; or
- 5 (2) provide reasonable flexibility that enhances the
- 6 agency's ability to achieve its mission.
- 7 (b) An agreement described by Subsection (a):
- 8 (1) must:
- 9 (A) be in writing;
- 10 (B) include the reasons telework is being
- 11 authorized;
- 12 (C) state the terms under which the agreement may
- 13 be revoked; and
- 14 (D) be renewed at least once each year after the
- 15 employee begins telework; and
- 16 (2) may be revoked by the state agency at any time and
- 17 without notice.
- 18 (c) A state agency may not offer telework as a condition of
- 19 employment by the agency.
- 20 (d) An agreement described by Subsection (a) does not
- 21 prohibit the employing state agency from requiring an employee to
- 22 report to the employee's regular or assigned temporary place of
- 23 employment or another work location on a day on which the agreement
- 24 otherwise authorizes telework for a meeting, special event, or
- 25 other engagement for which the agency determines in-person
- 26 interaction is necessary.
- Sec. 658.012. AGENCY TELEWORK PLAN. (a) A state agency

- 1 that authorizes telework under Section 658.011 shall develop a plan
- 2 that addresses the agency's telework policies and procedures. An
- 3 agency telework plan must:
- 4 <u>(1) establish:</u>
- 5 (A) criteria for evaluating the ability of an
- 6 employee to satisfactorily perform the employee's job duties while
- 7 <u>teleworking;</u>
- (B) performance standards that ensure a
- 9 teleworking employee maintains satisfactory performance;
- 10 (C) a system for monitoring the productivity of a
- 11 teleworking employee that ensures that the employee's work remains
- 12 satisfactory and that the employee's duties remain suitable for
- 13 telework; and
- 14 (D) appropriate physical and information
- 15 <u>security controls at teleworking sites;</u>
- 16 (2) ensure that a teleworking employee is subject to
- 17 the same rules and disciplinary actions as any other agency
- 18 employee; and
- 19 (3) prohibit a teleworking employee from conducting
- 20 in-person business at the employee's personal residence.
- 21 (b) A state agency that develops an agency telework plan
- 22 under this section shall publish the agency's telework plan on the
- 23 agency's publicly accessible Internet website.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
