A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the critical designation of certain natural gas
- 3 facilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 81.073(a), Subchapter C, Chapter 81,
- 6 Natural Resources Code, is amended as follows:
- 7 Sec. 81.073. CRITICAL NATURAL GAS FACILITIES AND ENTITIES.
- 8 (a) The commission shall collaborate with the Public
- 9 Utility Commission of Texas to adopt rules to establish a process to
- 10 designate certain natural gas facilities and entities associated
- 11 with providing natural gas in this state as critical customers or
- 12 critical gas suppliers during energy emergencies.
- 13 (b) The rules must:
- 14 (1) establish criteria for designating persons who own
- 15 or operate a facility under the jurisdiction of the commission
- 16 under Section 81.051(a) or engage in an activity under the
- 17 jurisdiction of the commission under Section 81.051(a) who must
- 18 provide critical customer and critical gas supply information, as
- 19 defined by the commission, to the entities described by Section
- 20 38.074(b)(1), Utilities Code;
- 21 (2) consider essential operational elements when
- 22 defining critical customer designations and critical gas supply
- 23 information for the purposes of Subdivision (1), including natural
- 24 gas production, processing, and transportation, related produced

- 1 water handling and disposal facilities, and the delivery of natural
- 2 gas to generators of electric energy; and
- 3 (3) require that only facilities and entities that are
- 4 prepared to operate during a weather emergency may be designated as
- 5 a critical customer under this section.; and
- 6 (4) establish criteria for a facility operated under
- 7 the jurisdiction of the commission which has been designated as
- 8 critical under (a) to be designated as critical on a seasonal
- 9 basis. In determining these criteria:
- 10 (i) the commission shall determine for which
- 11 <u>seasons each facility is designated critical and the begin</u>ning and
- 12 ending date of such seasons;
- 13 (ii) the commission shall grant any person who
- 14 owns or operates a facility which has been designated as critical
- 15 under (a) the right to apply to the commission to be designated as
- 16 <u>critical on a seasonal basis. Any such application may be made by an</u>
- 17 owner or operator as part of the owner or operator's Critical
- 18 Infrastructure Designation Report to the commission; and
- 19 <u>(iii)</u> the commission shall provide a list of
- 20 facilities designated as critical on a seasonal basis to the Public
- 21 <u>Utility Commission.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. (a) The Texas Railroad Commission shall open a
- 23 rulemaking to implement Natural Resources Code Subsection
- 24 81.073(b)(4). This rulemaking project shall begin not later than
- 25 the 90th day after the effective date of this Act. The commission
- 26 shall adopt the final rule not later than February 1, 2026. A list
- 27 of facilities designated as critical on a seasonal basis shall be

- 1 provided to the Public Utility Commission by March 31, 2026.
- 2 (b) The Public Utility Commission of Texas shall open a
- 3 rulemaking project requiring the independent organization
- 4 certified under Section 39.151 for the ERCOT power region to allow
- 5 facilities designated as critical on a seasonal basis, under
- 6 Natural Resources Code Subsection 81.073(b)(4), to participate in
- 7 competitively procured demand reductions. This rulemaking project
- 8 shall begin not later than the 90th day after the effective date of
- 9 this Act. The commission shall adopt the final rule not later than
- 10 February 1, 2026. The Public Utility Commission must provide the
- 11 list of facilities designated as critical on a seasonal basis to the
- 12 independent organization certified under Section 39.151 for the
- 13 ERCOT power region by April 30, 2026.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
