H.B. No. 5275

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to measures to ensure the safety of individuals with
- 3 disabilities during an emergency situation at public postsecondary
- 4 institutions.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 51.217(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) An institution shall adopt and implement a multihazard
- 9 emergency operations plan for use at the institution. The plan must
- 10 address mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery. The plan
- 11 must provide for:
- 12 (1) employee training in responding to an emergency;
- 13 (2) mandatory drills to prepare students, faculty, and
- 14 employees for responding to an emergency;
- 15 (3) measures to ensure coordination with the
- 16 Department of State Health Services, local emergency management
- 17 agencies, law enforcement, health departments, and fire
- 18 departments in the event of an emergency; [and]
- 19 (4) the implementation of a safety and security audit
- 20 as required by Subsection (c); and
- 21 (5) measures for ensuring that, during an emergency
- 22 <u>situation</u>, students, institution personnel, and guests with
- 23 disabilities are provided equal access to safety based on the rules
- 24 adopted by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board under

- 1 Section 61.06643, including the development of an emergency plan
- 2 that will accommodate individuals with different disabilities and
- 3 provide them with access to emergency evacuation assistance devices
- 4 in appropriate circumstances.
- 5 SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 51.222 to read as follows:
- 7 <u>Sec. 51.222. EMERGENCY EVACUATION ASSISTANCE DEVICES</u>
- 8 REQUIRED. (a) In this section, "institution of higher education"
- 9 has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- 10 (b) For each building that is located on the campus of an
- 11 institution of higher education and that has two or more floors, the
- 12 institution shall install on each floor emergency evacuation
- 13 <u>assistance devices for use by individuals with disabilities who</u>
- 14 require mobility assistance.
- 15 (c) An institution may use any available revenue, including
- 16 grants under Section 61.06644 and legislative appropriations, and
- 17 may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and donations from any public
- 18 or private source for the purposes of this section.
- 19 SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
- 20 amended by adding Sections 61.06643 and 61.06644 to read as
- 21 follows:
- Sec. 61.06643. RULES REGARDING MULTIHAZARD EMERGENCY
- 23 OPERATIONS PLAN PROVISIONS FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES. (a)
- 24 The board shall adopt rules for the required provisions in an
- 25 institution's multihazard emergency operations plan under Section
- 26 <u>51.217(b)(5)</u> to ensure the safety of students, institution
- 27 personnel, and guests with disabilities during an emergency

- 1 situation.
- 2 (b) In adopting rules under Subsection (a), the board shall
- 3 consult with:
- 4 (1) the advisory council on postsecondary education
- 5 for persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities
- 6 established under Section 61.06641;
- 7 (2) the Governor's Committee on People with
- 8 Disabilities; and
- 9 (3) the Texas Council for Developmental Disabilities.
- 10 (c) An institution must follow the rules adopted by the
- 11 board under Subsection (a) in adopting and implementing the
- 12 institution's multihazard emergency operations plan under Section
- 13 51.217.
- 14 Sec. 61.06644. EMERGENCY EVACUATION ASSISTANCE DEVICES FOR
- 15 INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES GRANT PROGRAM. (a) The board shall
- 16 <u>establish</u> and administer the emergency evacuation assistance
- 17 devices for individuals with disabilities grant program to provide
- 18 grants to institutions of higher education to enable those
- 19 institutions to purchase and install, and to train institution
- 20 personnel to operate, any emergency evacuation assistance devices
- 21 required under Section 51.222.
- (b) In awarding grants under this section, the board shall
- 23 give priority to institutions that demonstrate the highest need
- 24 based on the number of students on the institution's campus who
- 25 would require an emergency evacuation assistance device in an
- 26 emergency situation.
- 27 (c) A grant provided under this section:

- 1 (1) must be used for purchasing and installing any
- 2 emergency evacuation assistance devices required under Section
- 3 51.222; and
- 4 (2) may be used to provide any training that is
- 5 necessary for institution personnel to:
- 6 (A) administer the institution's evacuation plan
- 7 with respect to the devices; or
- 8 <u>(B) assist other individuals in operating the</u>
- 9 devices.
- 10 (d) The board may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and
- 11 donations from any public or private source for purposes of this
- 12 section.
- 13 (e) The board shall adopt rules for the administration of
- 14 this section, including rules creating a process for institutions
- 15 of higher education to apply for grants, establishing procedures
- 16 and criteria for evaluating those applications and awarding the
- 17 grants, and verifying that grant funds awarded under this section
- 18 are used appropriately.
- 19 SECTION 4. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 20 of this Act but not later than May 1, 2026, the Texas Higher
- 21 Education Coordinating Board shall adopt the rules required by
- 22 Sections 61.06643 and 61.06644, Education Code, as added by this
- 23 Act.
- SECTION 5. Section 51.222, Education Code, as added by this
- 25 Act, applies beginning with the 2026-2027 academic year.
- 26 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
