9	PLANNING REQUIREMENTS. (a) In this section, "institution of
10	higher education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
11	(b) Not later than June 1 of each even-numbered year, an
12	institution of higher education, in consultation with appropriate
13	law enforcement entities, shall prepare and submit to the
14	coordinating board a written report that includes:
15	(1) information on incidents of sexual assault
16	occurring within a two-mile radius of a campus of the institution
17	during the preceding two years, including the rate of those
18	incidents; and
