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school counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school 1 nurse is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal to the 2 3 sum of: 4 (1) the monthly salary the employee would have 5 received for the 2025-2026 school year under the district's salary schedule for the 2024-2025 school year, if that schedule had been in 6 effect for the 2025-2026 school year, including any local 7 8 supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement the employee would have received in the 2025-2026 school year; and 9 10 (2) \$1,500. (c-3) Subsection (c-2) and this subsection expire September 11 12 1, 2026. (d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time 13 14 school counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school 15 nurse employed by a school district in the 2025-2026 school year is, as long as the employee is employed by the same district, entitled 16 17 to a salary that is at least equal to the salary the employee received for the 2025-2026 school year. 18 19 SECTION 2. Section 22.107, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows: 20 21 (b-1) For the 2025-2026 school year, a school district shall increase the wages of each full-time employee, other than an 22 administrator or an employee subject to the minimum salary schedule 23 24 under Section 21.402, by 25 percent over the wages received by that employee in the 2024-2025 school year. A district employee to which 25 26 this subsection applies is entitled to wages in school years subsequent to the 2025-2026 school year in an amount that is at 27

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provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
