- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 437, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 437.054 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 437.054. ADJUTANT GENERAL: GENERAL POWERS. (a) The
- 8 adjutant general is the decision-making authority on all matters
- 9 concerning the location and maintenance of military forces and
- 10 facilities in this state. The adjutant general may set priorities
- 11 for the construction, renovation, repair, and maintenance of Texas
- 12 military forces armories, facilities, and improvements owned or
- 13 leased by this state. The adjutant general in this capacity is a
- 14 public authority and a body politic and corporate and has all powers
- 15 necessary for the acquisition, and procurement related to
- 16 construction, construction, rental, control, maintenance,
- 17 operation, and disposition of Texas military forces facilities and
- 18 real property and all associated property and equipment.
- 19 (b) The adjutant general may execute the cooperative
- 20 agreements with the National Guard Bureau and an interagency
- 21 military agreement with a federal, state, or local governmental or
- 22 quasi-governmental agency.
- 23 (c) The adjutant general may delegate the authority granted
- 24 under this section in whole or in part.
