SECTION 2. Section 2054.603(e), Government Code, as added 13 14 by this Act, is intended to clarify rather than change existing law. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
