- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 2054.603, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(e)</u> Contract language in a cybersecurity insurance contract
- 9 or other contract for goods or services prohibiting or restricting
- 10 a state agency's or local government's compliance with this section
- 11 or otherwise circumventing the requirements of this section is void
- 12 <u>and unenforceable.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 2054.603(e), Government Code, as added
- 14 by this Act, is intended to clarify rather than change existing law.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
