- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1001.053, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1001.053. PUBLIC WORKS. The following work is exempt
- 8 from this chapter:
- 9 (1) a public work that involves electrical or
- 10 mechanical engineering, if the contemplated expense for the
- 11 completed project is \$8,000 or less;
- 12 (2) a public work that does not involve electrical or
- 13 mechanical engineering, if the contemplated expense for the
- 14 completed project is \$100,000 [<del>\$20,000</del>] or less; or
- 15 (3) road maintenance or improvement undertaken by the
- 16 commissioners court of a county.
- 17 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 18 a public work project initiated on or after the effective date of
- 19 this Act. A public work project initiated before the effective date
- 20 of this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately before
- 21 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
- 22 for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
