1 <u>QUALIFICATIONS</u>. <u>(a)</u> The medical examiner may, subject to the 2 approval of the commissioners court, employ such <u>assistant or</u> 3 deputy <u>medical</u> examiners, scientific experts, trained technicians, 4 officers and employees as may be necessary to the proper 5 performance of the duties imposed by this Article upon the medical 6 examiner.

7 (b) An assistant or deputy medical examiner employed under 8 this section must hold or be eligible to hold a certification issued 9 by the American Board of Pathology in anatomic pathology and 10 forensic pathology.

SECTION 3. Section 2(b), Article 49.25, Code of Criminal Procedure, is repealed.
