2	relating to the establishment of the Cross-Agency Employment
3	Resource Initiative to coordinate and optimize certain employment
4	services and resources in this state.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subtitle G, Title 10, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Chapter 2308B to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 2308B. CROSS-AGENCY EMPLOYMENT RESOURCE INITIATIVE
9	Sec. 2308B.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Client" means an individual who:
11	(A) receives services from the workforce
12	commission;
13	(B) is a recipient of financial assistance under
14	Chapter 31, Human Resources Code, or supplemental nutrition
15	assistance under Chapter 33, Human Resources Code; or
16	(C) receives reentry and reintegration services
17	from the department.
18	(2) "Commission" means the Health and Human Services
19	Commission.
20	(3) "Department" means the Texas Department of
21	Criminal Justice.
22	(4) "Initiative" means the Cross-Agency Employment
23	Resource Initiative.
24	(5) "Workforce commission" means the Texas Workforce

- 2 Sec. 2308B.002. PURPOSE. The Cross-Agency Employment
- 3 Resource Initiative is established to coordinate and optimize
- 4 services, information, and other resources as necessary to:
- 5 (1) align services provided to clients of programs
- 6 administered by the workforce commission who also use programs
- 7 administered by the commission or the department, or both;
- 8 (2) provide those clients with timely and accurate
- 9 information necessary to meet program requirements;
- 10 (3) enable the agencies to maximize and leverage
- 11 resources, including client data and agency office space, to
- 12 effectively and efficiently serve clients using multiple programs
- 13 across the agencies; and
- 14 (4) share individual agency goals and performance
- 15 measures, specifically those attributed to gainful employment,
- 16 employment retention, recidivism, and other workforce development
- 17 goals, and enable state and local policy makers to collaboratively
- 18 implement or modify policy and regulations to effect those goals.
- 19 Sec. 2308B.003. INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS. The commission,
- 20 department, and workforce commission shall enter into one or more
- 21 interagency agreements establishing policies and processes for:
- 22 <u>(1) sharing relevant client data and agency</u>
- 23 <u>information; and</u>
- 24 (2) sharing agency office space and other resources as
- 25 necessary to effectuate the purposes of the initiative.
- Sec. 2308B.004. QUARTERLY DISCUSSIONS. The executive
- 27 commissioner of the commission, the chair of the Texas Board of

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- 1 Criminal Justice, and the chair of the workforce commission shall
- 2 discuss the work of the initiative at least once per quarter.
- 3 Sec. 2308B.005. GIFTS, GRANTS, AND DONATIONS. (a) The
- 4 commission, department, and workforce commission may accept gifts,
- 5 grants, and donations from any public or private source for
- 6 purposes of the initiative.
- 7 (b) The commission, department, and workforce commission
- 8 shall investigate potential sources of funding from federal grants
- 9 or programs that may be used for purposes of the initiative.
- 10 SECTION 2. Not later than October 1, 2025, the executive
- 11 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission, the chair
- 12 of the Texas Board of Criminal Justice, and the chair of the Texas
- 13 Workforce Commission shall hold the initial discussion required
- 14 under Section 2308B.004, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
