- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 472, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 472.0355 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 472.0355. DESIGNATION OF METROPOLITAN LANE. (a) By a
- 8 majority vote of the policy board, a metropolitan planning
- 9 organization may designate up to 10 percent of the lane miles of
- 10 public highways located within the territorial boundaries of the
- 11 organization as metropolitan lanes.
- 12 (b) On the designation of a metropolitan lane, a
- 13 governmental entity of this state, with the approval of the
- 14 governing body having primary jurisdiction over the metropolitan
- 15 lane, may implement on the metropolitan lane a project that:
- 16 (1) uses transit priority lanes or high occupancy
- 17 vehicle lanes or otherwise increases the highway's capacity to
- 18 transport people by public transportation, rail, or high-speed
- 19 rail; or

- 20 (2) optimizes the highway for pedestrians, cyclists,
- 21 users of personal mobility devices, or other low-mass, low-speed
- 22 road users.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
