H.B. No. 5435

- 2 relating to required lease terms for public property leased to a
- 3 nongovernmental entity.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 2252.909(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 6 as added by Chapter 1008 (H.B. 2518), Acts of the 88th Legislature,
- 7 Regular Session, 2023, are amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Emergency" means a sudden, urgent occurrence that
- 10 requires immediate action.
- 11 (2) "Governmental [$_{\tau}$ "governmental] entity" has the
- 12 meaning assigned by Section 2253.001.
- 13 (b) A lease between a governmental entity and another person
- 14 regarding public property must contain lease terms requiring the
- 15 person to:
- 16 (1) include in each contract for the construction,
- 17 alteration, or repair of an improvement to the leased property a
- 18 condition that the contractor:
- 19 (A) if the contract meets the description in
- 20 Section 2253.021(a)(2)(A) or $(B)_{,}$ execute a payment bond that
- 21 conforms to Subchapter I, Chapter 53, Property Code; and
- 22 (B) if the contract meets the description in
- 23 <u>Section 2253.021(a)(1),</u> execute a performance bond in an amount
- 24 equal to the amount of the contract for the protection of the

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- 1 governmental entity and conditioned on the faithful performance of
- 2 the contractor's work in accordance with the plans, specifications,
- 3 and contract documents; and
- 4 (2) provide to the governmental entity a notice of
- 5 commencement consistent with this section:
- 6 (A) at least 90 days before the date the
- 7 construction, alteration, or repair of any improvement to the
- 8 leased property begins; or
- 9 (B) in the event of an emergency, at least 30 days
- 10 before the date the construction, alteration, or repair of any
- 11 improvement to the leased property begins.
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 13 to a lease between a governmental entity and another person
- 14 regarding public property that is entered into on or after the
- 15 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
