- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 554.002(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A state or local governmental entity may not suspend or
- 7 terminate the employment of, or take other adverse personnel action
- 8 against, a public employee who in good faith reports <u>wasteful or</u>
- 9 fraudulent spending or a violation of law by the employing
- 10 governmental entity, [or] another public employee, or an elected
- 11 officer of the employing governmental entity to an appropriate law
- 12 enforcement authority.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
