1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to resident tuition rates and fees at public institutions
1-18 of higher education for certain students in military-related
1-19 programs.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-21 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
1-22 amended by adding Section 54.224 to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 54.224. RESIDENT TUITION FOR STUDENTS IN
1-24 MILITARY-RELATED PROGRAMS. (a) A person enrolled at an
1-25 institution of higher education is entitled to pay tuition and fees
1-26 at the rates provided for Texas residents if the person is:

- 1-27 (1) enrolled and in good standing in a Reserve
1-28 Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) program;
1-29 (2) enrolled in a corps of cadets, including a corps of
1-30 cadets at a senior military college; or
1-31 (3) enrolled in a corps of midshipmen.

1-32 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a person who is entitled
1-33 to pay resident tuition and fees only as permitted by this section
1-34 is not considered a Texas resident under this subchapter for
1-35 purposes of a financial aid program offered by this state.

1-36 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
1-37 beginning with tuition and other fees charged for the 2025 fall
1-38 semester. Tuition and other fees charged for an academic period
1-39 before that semester are covered by the law in effect immediately
1-40 before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is
1-41 continued in effect for that purpose.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-43 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-44 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
