A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the creation of the Fort Bend County Water Control and Improvement District No. 13; granting a limited power of eminent 3 domain; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to 4 5 impose assessments, fees, and taxes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Subtitle I, Title 6, Special District Local Laws 7 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 9095 to read as follows: 8 9 CHAPTER 9095. FORT BEND COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 13 10 11 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS 12 Sec. 9095.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: "Board" means the district's board of directors. 13 (1) (2) "Commission" means the <u>Texas</u> Commission on 14 15 Environmental Quality. 16 (3) "Director" means a board member. (4) "District" means the Fort Bend County Water 17 Control and Improvement District No. 13. 18 Sec. 9095.0102. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a water 19 control and improvement district created under Section 59, Article 20 XVI, Texas Constitution. 21 Sec. 9095.0103. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTOR ELECTION 22 23 REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent 24

1	directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.
2	Sec. 9095.0104. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. The
3	temporary directors may not hold an election under Section
4	9095.0103 until each municipality in whose corporate limits or
5	extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has
6	consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of the
7	district and to the inclusion of land in the district as required by
8	applicable law.
9	Sec. 9095.0105. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT.
10	(a) The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit.
11	(b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of:
12	(1) a water control and improvement district as
13	provided by general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas
14	Constitution, including the collection, transportation,
15	processing, disposal, and control of domestic, industrial, or
16	communal waste and the gathering, conducting, diverting, and
17	control of local storm water or other harmful excesses of water; and
18	(2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that
19	relate to the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation,
20	or maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or
21	improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.
22	Sec. 9095.0106. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
23	district is initially composed of the territory described by
24	Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.
25	(b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
26	the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the
27	field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process

1	does not affect the district's:

8	SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS										
9	Sec. 9095.0201. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is										
10	governed by a board of five elected directors.										
11	(b) Except as provided by Section 9095.0202, directors										
12	serve staggered four-year terms.										
13	Sec. 9095.0202. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) The temporary										
14	board consists of:										
15	(1) Amanda Flynt;										
16	(2) Jason Scholtz;										
17	(3) Carlos Bujosa;										
18	(4) Regina Landreneau; and										
19	(5) Stephen Pheigaru.										
20	(b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:										
21	(1) the date permanent directors are elected under										
22	<u>Section 9095.0103; or</u>										
23	(2) the fourth anniversary of the effective date of										
24	the Act enacting this chapter.										
25	(c) If permanent directors have not been elected under										
26	Section 9095.0103 and the terms of the temporary directors have										
27	expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or										

1	reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that
2	expire on the earlier of:
3	(1) the date permanent directors are elected under
4	Section 9095.0103; or
5	(2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the
6	appointment or reappointment.
7	(d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a
8	majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district
9	may submit a petition to the commission requesting that the
10	commission appoint as successor temporary directors the five
11	persons named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as
12	successor temporary directors the five persons named in the
13	petition.
14	SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES
15	Sec. 9095.0301. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district
16	has the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for
17	which the district is created.
18	Sec. 9095.0302. WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
19	POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided
20	by the general law of this state applicable to water control and
21	improvement districts created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas
22	Constitution, including Chapters 49 and 51, Water Code, and
23	specifically including the powers and duties authorized under
24	Subchapter H, Chapter 51, Water Code.
25	Sec. 9095.0303. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. Under Section
26	52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may design,
27	acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, operate,

1 maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a municipality for 2 operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or 3 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads. 4 Sec. 9095.0304. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A 5 road project must meet all applicable construction standards, zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulations of each 6 7 municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial 8 jurisdiction the road project is located.

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9 (b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits 10 or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road 11 project must meet all applicable construction standards, 12 subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which 13 the road project is located.

14 (c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the 15 Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and 16 specifications of the road project.

17 Sec. 9095.0305. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION. The district shall comply with all 18 19 applicable requirements of any ordinance or resolution that is adopted under Section 42.042 or 42.0425, Local Government Code, and 20 consents to the creation of the district or to the inclusion of land 21 22 in the district. Sec. 9095.0306. LIMITATION ON USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN. 23 The 24 district may not exercise the power of eminent domain outside the

3	Sec. 9095.0401. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS. (a)
4	The district may issue, without an election, bonds and other
5	obligations secured by:
6	(1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or
7	(2) contract payments described by Section 9095.0403.
8	(b) The district must hold an election in the manner
9	provided by Chapters 49 and 51, Water Code, to obtain voter approval
10	before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds

12	(c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem
13	taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a

16	Sec. 9095.0402. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
17	authorized at an election held under Section 9095.0401, the
18	district may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable
19	property in the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water
20	<u>Code.</u>
21	(b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
22	exceed the rate approved at the election.
23	Sec. 9095.0403. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with
24	Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than
25	an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from
26	the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of
27	the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters

1 voting at an election held for that purpose. 2 (b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a 3 provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by the board without further voter approval. 4 5 SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS Sec. 9095.0501. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER 6 7 OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations 8 payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees, revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any 9 10 combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district 11 purpose. Sec. 9095.0502. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district 12 issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the 13 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing 14 15 direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner 16 17 provided by Chapter 51, Water Code. Sec. 9095.0503. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of 18 19 issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad 20 valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the 21 22 real property in the district. Sec. 9095.0504. BONDS FOR RECREATIONAL FACILITIES. 23 (a) 24 The district may develop recreational facilities and issue bonds for recreational facilities as provided by Chapter 49, Water Code, 25 26 regardless of whether the district's territory overlaps with the territory of a political subdivision that is authorized to develop 27

1 recreational facilities and issue bonds for recreational 2 facilities under Chapter 49, Water Code. 3 (b) The authority of the district to develop recreational

4 <u>facilities and issue bonds for recreational facilities under this</u> 5 <u>section does not limit the authority of another political</u> 6 <u>subdivision whose territory the territory of the district may</u> 7 <u>overlap, wholly or partly, to develop recreational facilities and</u> 8 <u>issue bonds for recreational facilities under Chapter 49, Water</u> 9 <u>Code.</u>

(a) The legal notice of the intention to 20 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 21 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 22 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 23 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 24 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 25 Government Code.

(b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has27 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on

1 Environmental Quality.

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed (c) 2 3 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the governor, and the speaker of 4 lieutenant the house of 5 representatives within the required time.

6 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 7 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 8 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 9 and accomplished.

10 SECTION 4. (a) Section 9095.0306, Special District Local 11 Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of this Act, takes effect only if 12 this Act receives a two-thirds vote of all the members elected to 13 each house.

(b) If this Act does not receive a two-thirds vote of all the
members elected to each house, Subchapter C, Chapter 9095, Special
District Local Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of this Act, is
amended by adding Section 9095.0306 to read as follows:

18 <u>Sec. 9095.0306. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may</u> 19 <u>not exercise the power of eminent domain.</u>

(c) This section is not intended to be an expression of a
legislative interpretation of the requirements of Section 17(c),
Article I, Texas Constitution.

23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
