1 WHEREAS, For 125 years, the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the 2

United States has rendered exceptional service to former members of

our nation's armed forces; and 3

WHEREAS, The VFW traces its origins to 1899, when veterans of 4

5 the Spanish-American War and the Philippine-American War founded

local organizations in Ohio, Colorado, and Pennsylvania to advocate

for their rights and secure benefits such as medical care and 7

pensions; the movement quickly gained momentum, and the groups 8

9 banded together to form the VFW; today, the organization and the VFW

10 Auxiliary boast memberships totaling more than 1.4 million; and

11 WHEREAS, Since its inception, the VFW has supported a wide

range of veterans' benefits programs, and it has offered guidance

to countless former service members in their transition back to

14 civilian life; in addition, the organization has made a positive

impact in local communities, and it has distinguished itself as a 15

16 national leader on issues important to veterans and their families;

18 WHEREAS, The VFW's many contributions have included

advocating for the establishment of the Veterans Administration 19

(now known as the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs) and the 20

21 national cemetery system, fighting for improved health care for

women veterans, and providing funds for a number of memorials 22

23 honoring military service members; the organization has also played

an instrumental role in the passage of legislation such as the GI 24

H.C.R. No. 7

- 1 Bill for the 21st Century in 2008, the Veterans Access, Choice, and
- 2 Accountability Act of 2014, the 2019 Blue Water Navy Vietnam
- 3 Veterans Act, and the 2022 Honoring Our PACT Act; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt of gratitude to the
- 5 military personnel who put themselves in harm's way to defend our
- 6 safety, security, and freedom, and the VFW is indeed deserving of
- 7 special recognition for its efforts to ensure that veterans receive
- 8 the support and appreciation they deserve; now, therefore, be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas
- 10 hereby designate September 29 as Veterans of Foreign Wars of the
- 11 United States Day; and, be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of
- 13 Section 391.004(d), Government Code, this designation remain in
- 14 effect until the 10th anniversary of the date this resolution is
- 15 finally passed by the legislature.
