

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Junior League of Midland is celebrating 75 years
2 of service to the community in 2024; and

3 WHEREAS, Originally known as the Midland Service League, the
4 Junior League of Midland was founded in 1949 with the mission to
5 advance women's leadership through volunteer action,
6 collaboration, and training; in 1964, it was officially admitted as
7 the 195th league in the Association of Junior Leagues, and over the
8 years, it has amassed an impressive record of community service and
9 supported countless individuals and families in need; today, the
10 organization counts nearly 600 members who annually donate more
11 than 16,000 hours of service; and

12 WHEREAS, Among its many initiatives, the Junior League offers
13 an after-school reading program at the Boys & Girls Clubs of the
14 Permian Basin in Midland, and it holds weekly workshops as part of
15 its Suits with Skills project, which provides job-skills mentoring
16 for female survivors of domestic abuse; in 2017, the organization
17 partnered with Communities in Schools of the Permian Basin to
18 create IMPACT yearlong mentoring programming for local at-risk
19 students; moreover, the group's most recent endeavor, Pink Pantry,
20 provides feminine and basic hygiene supplies to students at several
21 Midland Independent School District schools; and

22 WHEREAS, Over the past 75 years, the people of Midland have
23 been fortunate to benefit from the far-reaching contributions of
24 the Junior League, and it is a pleasure to join in honoring the

1 group's proud tradition of leadership, service, and civic
2 engagement; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas
4 hereby commend the Junior League of Midland for its exemplary
5 record of service and that all those associated with the
6 organization be extended sincere best wishes for continued success
7 with their important work; and, be it further

8 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
9 prepared for the Junior League of Midland as an expression of high
10 regard by the Texas House of Representatives and Senate.
