

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The city of Longview lost a beloved resident with
2 the passing of Tracy Lee Vincent on July 30, 2024, at the age of 66;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, The son of Helen Hazel and James Thomas Vincent,
5 Tracy Vincent was born in Jacksonville on January 12, 1958, and he
6 grew up with the companionship of two brothers, Tommy and Harvey; he
7 graduated from Jacksonville High School in 1977; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Vincent relocated to Tyler in 1985 and
9 subsequently embarked on a fulfilling career in
10 telecommunications; while there, he was a dedicated member of Rose
11 Heights Church; after moving to Longview in 1995, he became highly
12 active in his community, giving generously of his time and talents
13 to a number of organizations, including as a member of the Longview
14 Chamber of Commerce and as chair of the Republican Party of Gregg
15 County from 2017 to 2019; moreover, he previously served as a
16 Republican precinct chair as well as a delegate to the Republican
17 National Convention, and he was involved in a number of other
18 political groups, such as the East Texans for Liberty Political
19 Action Committee and We The People-Longview; and

20 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Vincent benefited from the
21 love and support of his wife, Donna, and he was the proud father of
22 seven children, Brandi, Justin, Melissa, Christopher, Melissa,
23 Stephanie, and Korbin; over the years, he was further blessed with
24 15 grandchildren and a great-grandchild; in his leisure time, he

1 enjoyed hunting and fishing, and he was also known for his
2 entertaining campfire stories and spontaneous pranks; a man of
3 strong faith, he and his wife were members of Mobberly Baptist
4 Church; and

5 WHEREAS, While the death of Tracy Vincent brings great
6 sadness to his family and friends, he leaves behind a legacy that
7 will long be treasured by all those who held him dear; now,
8 therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas
10 hereby pay tribute to the life of Tracy Lee Vincent and extend
11 sincere condolences to his loved ones; and, be it further

12 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
13 prepared for his family and that when the Texas House of
14 Representatives and Senate adjourn this day, they do so in memory of
15 Tracy Vincent.
