HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, The development of the city of Pineland has been
- 2 profoundly shaped by its lumber industry, which has formed the
- 3 basis of the community's economy since its founding at the turn of
- 4 the 20th century; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Located in southwestern Sabine County, Pineland
- 6 traces its origins to a sawmill and lumber camp that was established
- 7 on the Gulf, Beaumont and Great Northern Railway, which laid tracks
- 8 through the county in 1902; originally known as John Adam's Mill,
- 9 the community acquired its Pineland name when a post office opened
- 10 in 1904; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Nestled in the heart of the East Texas forests,
- 12 Pineland grew rapidly as a company town centered around the Temple
- 13 Lumber Company, which was established in 1910 when Thomas L. L.
- 14 Temple took control of a previously existing mill operation;
- 15 through the decades, the company's products included hardwood,
- 16 plywood, pine lumber, particleboard, and hardwood flooring, and a
- 17 number of new processing facilities were added beginning in the
- 18 1960s; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The company became Temple Industries in 1963, and
- 20 additional name changes took place over the next two decades due to
- 21 a series of acquisitions and mergers; since 2013, Georgia-Pacific
- 22 has operated the mill, and when a \$120 million expansion of the
- 23 Pineland Lumber Complex was completed in 2023, it became the
- 24 largest sawmill in the southern United States; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Drawing on the region's vast timber resources,
- 2 Pineland has played an integral role in the state's lumber industry
- 3 for more than a century, and the city's residents are justifiably
- 4 proud of their community's contributions to the Texas economy; now,
- 5 therefore, be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas
- 7 hereby designate Pineland as the official Sawmill Capital of Texas;
- 8 and, be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of
- 10 Section 391.003(e), Government Code, this designation remain in
- 11 effect until the 10th anniversary of the date this resolution is
- 12 finally passed by the legislature.
