HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, For a century, families have come together to 2 worship at Austin Oaks Church, and the congregation is celebrating 3 the 100th anniversary of the church's founding in 2025; and

WHEREAS, Originally known as the Swedish Evangelical Free Church of Austin, this venerable house of worship was formed on August 16, 1925, as part of the Evangelical Free Churches, a movement established by Swedish immigrants; its first sanctuary was located in downtown Austin, and services were conducted entirely in Swedish until the decision was made to transition to English in the late 1930s; and

11 WHEREAS, The church relocated twice during the decades that 12 followed, eventually settling on a campus off of Monterey Oaks 13 Boulevard in southwest Austin in 2002; it went on to adopt its 14 current name, Austin Oaks Church, in 2014; and

WHEREAS, Over the years, the congregation has benefited from 15 16 the dedicated efforts of many outstanding pastors, and today that tradition of service is continued by lead pastor Brandon Zieske and 17 executive pastor BJ Forguson; under their leadership, Austin Oaks 18 offers a wide variety of ministries for members seeking to deepen 19 their faith and become more involved in church life, including 20 groups for men, women, and young adults, Spanish-language services, 21 and global and community outreach programs; and 22

23 WHEREAS, Generations of Texans have looked to Austin Oaks 24 Church for spiritual guidance and inspiration, and it is a pleasure
