HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Banana Pudding Festival serves as a cheerful salute to Slaton's deep culinary roots, its thriving community spirit, and the longstanding legacy of the Slaton Bakery, and it is fitting that this beloved event be appropriately recognized; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas hereby designate Slaton as the official Banana Pudding Capital of Texas; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section 391.003(e), Government Code, this designation remain in effect until the 10th anniversary of the date this resolution is finally passed by the legislature.
