

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Cody C. Campbell was elected chair of the Texas Tech  
2 University System Board of Regents on April 14, 2025; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Campbell was appointed to the board of regents  
4 by Governor Greg Abbott in April 2021, and over the course of his  
5 tenure, he has also served as vice chair of its Finance &  
6 Investments Committee, as well as of the Carr Foundation Board of  
7 Trustees; and

8 WHEREAS, Bringing to his position a wealth of knowledge and  
9 experience, Mr. Campbell previously served on the Texas Higher  
10 Education Coordinating Board and the Texas Tech University Rawls  
11 College of Business Advisory Council; moreover, he cofounded and is  
12 a board member of the Matador Club, and he further gives generously  
13 of his time and talents to the boards of a number of other worthy  
14 organizations, including the Texas Public Policy Foundation and All  
15 Saints' Episcopal School of Fort Worth; and

16 WHEREAS, A fourth-generation Red Raider, Mr. Campbell holds  
17 bachelor's degrees in finance and economics and a master's degree in  
18 finance from Texas Tech, where he was a four-year letterman on the  
19 offensive line for the football team from 2001 to 2004, and he went  
20 on to spend two seasons in the National Football League with the  
21 Indianapolis Colts; currently, he is co-chief executive officer of  
22 Double Eagle Energy Holdings, a Fort Worth-based upstream  
23 exploration and production company that he helped to establish, and  
24 he also is the president and a board member of Double Eagle

2 WHEREAS, In taking on this new challenge, Cody Campbell has  
3 demonstrated a profound commitment to advancing the important goals  
4 of one of the largest systems of higher education in the Lone Star  
5 State; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas  
7 hereby congratulate Cody C. Campbell on his election as chair of the  
8 Texas Tech University System Board of Regents and extend to him  
9 sincere best wishes for a successful tenure; and, be it further
