- 1 WHEREAS, House Bill No. 46 has been adopted by the house of
- 2 representatives and the senate and is being prepared for
- 3 enrollment; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The bill contains a technical error that should be
- 5 corrected; now, therefore, be it
- 6 RESOLVED by the 89th Legislature of the State of Texas, That
- 7 the enrolling clerk of the house of representatives be instructed
- 8 to make the following corrections to the enrolled version of House
- 9 Bill No. 46:
- In SECTION 16 of the bill, in added Section 169.006(b),
- 11 Occupations Code (page 11, lines 16-20), strike "Notwithstanding
- 12 any other provision of this chapter, low-THC cannabis prescribed
- 13 under Subsection (a) for pulmonary inhalation may exceed one
- 14 percent by weight of tetrahydrocannabinols in each dosage unit of
- 15 the substance to be aerosolized or vaporized.".
