A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature

- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 9 adding Section 1-y to read as follows:
- Sec. 1-y. (a) The legislature by general law may exempt
- 11 from ad valorem taxation the amount of the market value of real
- 12 property located in a county that borders the United Mexican States
- 13 that arises from the installation or construction on the property
- 14 of border security infrastructure and related improvements.
- 15 (b) The legislature by general law may define "border
- 16 security infrastructure" for the purposes of this section and may
- 17 prescribe additional eligibility requirements for the exemption
- 18 <u>authorized by this section.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 20 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 21 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 22 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize the
- 23 legislature to provide for an exemption from ad valorem taxation of
- 24 the amount of the market value of real property located in a county
