- 8 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 9 adding Section 1-b-1 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 1-b-1. (a) The legislature by general law may exempt
- from ad valorem taxation a portion of the market value of the real 11
- property a person owns that is the primary residence of an adult who 12
- has an intellectual or developmental disability and who must be 13
- related to the owner or trustee of the property within the third 14
- degree by consanguinity. 15
- (b) The portion of the market value of real property 16
- authorized to be exempted under Subsection (a) of this section is 17
- equal to the amount of the exemption provided by Section 1-b(c) of 18
- 19 this article applicable to the residence homestead of a married or
- unmarried adult, including one living alone. 20
- 21 (c) The legislature may define "developmental disability"
- and "intellectual disability" for purposes of this section. 22
- 23 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025. 24
