A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment regarding the dedication by
- 2 general law of money received by this state and money held in or
- 3 deposited to an account or fund inside or outside the state treasury
- 4 and the authorized expenditure or appropriation of money dedicated
- 5 by general law.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 26 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 26. (a) The legislature by general law may dedicate
- 10 to one or more particular purposes the appropriation or expenditure
- 11 of money:
- 12 (1) received by this state from one or more particular
- 13 sources; or
- 14 (2) held in or deposited to an identified account or
- 15 fund inside or outside the state treasury.
- (b) Subsection (a) of this section does not authorize a
- 17 dedication by general law of money otherwise dedicated by this
- 18 constitution in a manner that is inconsistent with that
- 19 <u>constitutional dedication</u>.
- 20 <u>(c) Money the appropriation or expenditure of which is</u>
- 21 dedicated by general law to a purpose or purposes as described by
- 22 Subsection (a) of this section may not be appropriated or expended
- 23 for any purpose other than the dedicated purpose or purposes,
- 24 except as authorized by a subsequently adopted general law that:

- 1 (1) expressly amends or repeals the general law under
- 2 which the money was dedicated; and
- 3 (2) is adopted by a record vote of two-thirds of the
- 4 membership of both houses of the legislature.
- 5 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 6 the Texas Constitution:
- 7 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 8 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 89th Legislature,
- 9 Regular Session, 2025, regarding the dedication by general law of
- 10 money received by this state and money held in or deposited to an
- 11 account or fund inside or outside the state treasury and the
- 12 authorized expenditure or appropriation of money dedicated by
- 13 general law.
- 14 (b) Section 26, Article VIII, of this constitution takes
- 15 effect September 1, 2027, and applies only to appropriations
- 16 <u>authorized for or expenditures during a state fiscal year beginning</u>
- 17 on or after that date.
- 18 (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2028.
- 19 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 20 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 21 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 22 proposition: "The constitutional amendment regarding the
- 23 dedication by general law of money received by this state and money
- 24 held in or deposited to an account or fund inside or outside the
- 25 state treasury and the authorized expenditure or appropriation of
- 26 money dedicated by general law."
