A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 9 adding Section 1-u to read as follows:
- Sec. 1-u. The legislature by general law may authorize the
- 11 commissioners court of a county to exempt from ad valorem taxation
- 12 by each political subdivision that taxes the property the portion
- of the assessed value of a person's property that is attributable to
- 14 the installation in or on the property of a rainwater harvesting or
- 15 graywater system and may provide additional eligibility
- 16 requirements for the exemption.
- 17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 18 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 19 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize the
- 21 commissioners court of a county to exempt from ad valorem taxation
- 22 by each political subdivision that taxes the property the portion
- 23 of the assessed value of a person's property that is attributable to
- 24 the installation in or on the property of a rainwater harvesting or

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1 graywater system."
