H.J.R. No. 91

A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment recognizing the right of an  
2 individual to refuse a vaccination.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by  
5 adding Section 37 to read as follows:

6 Sec. 37. An individual has the unalienable and natural  
7 right to refuse a vaccination. The vaccination status of an  
8 individual may not be made a condition of employment, travel,  
9 school or other educational institution attendance, conducting  
10 business, receiving governmental services, or any other action in  
11 this state.

12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be  
13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.  
14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the  
15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment recognizing the right  
16 of an individual to refuse a vaccination."
