## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment abolishing the automatic
- 2 resignation of certain municipal, county, or district
- 3 officeholders if they become candidates for another office.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11(a), Article XI, Texas Constitution,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A Home Rule City may provide by charter or charter
- 8 amendment, and a city, town or village operating under the general
- 9 laws may provide by majority vote of the qualified voters voting at
- 10 an election called for that purpose, for a longer term of office
- 11 than two (2) years for its officers, either elective or appointive,
- 12 or both, but not to exceed four (4) years; provided, however, that
- 13 tenure under Civil Service shall not be affected hereby[; provided,
- 14 however, that such officers, elective or appointive, are subject to
- 15 Section 65(b), Article XVI, of this constitution, providing for
- 16 automatic resignation in certain circumstances, in the same manner
- 17 as a county or district officer to which that section applies].
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 65, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is
- 19 repealed.
- 20 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 21 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 22 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 23 proposition: "The constitutional amendment abolishing the
- 24 automatic resignation of certain municipal, county, or district
