## A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing legislative 2 action at any time after the thirtieth day of the regular session of 3 the legislature.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 5(b), Article III, Texas Constitution, 6 is amended to read as follows:

7 (b) When convened in regular Session, the first thirty days thereof shall be devoted to the introduction of bills and 8 9 resolutions, acting upon emergency appropriations, passing upon the confirmation of the recess appointees of the Governor and such 10 11 emergency matters as may be submitted by the Governor in special 12 messages to the Legislature. [During the succeeding thirty days of the regular session of the Legislature the various committees of 13 14 each House shall hold hearings to consider all bills and resolutions and other matters then pending; and such emergency 15 matters as may be submitted by the Governor. During the remainder 16 of the session the Legislature shall act upon such bills and 17 resolutions as may be then pending and upon such emergency matters 18 as may be submitted by the Governor in special messages to the 19 20 Legislature.]

21 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 22 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025. 23 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the 24 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing legislative
