A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment regarding the time during
- 2 which the legislature may act on bills or resolutions during a
- 3 regular session.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 5(b), Article III, Texas Constitution,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) When convened in regular Session, the first thirty days
- 8 thereof shall be devoted to the introduction of bills and
- 9 resolutions, acting upon emergency appropriations, passing upon
- 10 the confirmation of the recess appointees of the Governor and such
- 11 emergency matters as may be submitted by the Governor in special
- 12 messages to the Legislature. [During the succeeding thirty days of
- 13 the regular session of the Legislature the various committees of
- 14 each House shall hold hearings to consider all bills and
- 15 resolutions and other matters then pending; and such emergency
- 16 matters as may be submitted by the Governor. During the remainder
- 17 of the session the Legislature shall <u>hold hearings and</u> act upon such
- 18 bills and resolutions as may be then pending and upon such emergency
- 19 matters as may be submitted by the Governor in special messages to
- 20 the Legislature.
- 21 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 22 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 23 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 24 proposition: "The constitutional amendment regarding the time
