H.J.R. No. 155

A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment establishing a parent's right
2 to direct a child's education.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by
5 adding Section 37 to read as follows:

6 Sec. 37. (a) In this section, "parent" means a natural
7 parent, stepparent, adoptive parent, legal guardian, or other legal
8 custodian of a child.

9 (b) A parent has the right to direct the education of the
10 parent's child, including the right to:

11 (1) make reasonable choices within the public school
12 system;

13 (2) choose an alternative to public education, such as
14 a private school, including a parochial school or home school;

15 (3) access and view public school teaching materials,
16 textbooks and other instructional materials, and library books;

17 (4) attend meetings of the governing body of a public
18 school; and

19 (5) access public school student records for the
20 parent's child, including the child's student health records.

21 (c) The rights described by Subsection (b) of this section
22 may not be denied or restricted because the parent or the child is
23 an individual with a disability.

24 (d) The legislature by general law may provide for processes

1 to ensure that the rights described by Subsection (b) of this
2 section are upheld.

3 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
4 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
5 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
6 proposition: "The constitutional amendment establishing a
7 parent's right to direct a child's education."
