1        WHEREAS, Family and friends suffered an immeasurable loss  
2 with the tragic passing of Lyndsey Captain Vicknair of Manor on June  
3 15, 2024, at the age of 33; and

4        WHEREAS, Born on December 31, 1990, to Bobby and Lena  
5 Captain, the former Lyndsey Captain grew up with the companionship  
6 of a sister, Laura-Marie; after graduating from Mansfield High  
7 School in 2008, she earned her bachelor's degree in criminal  
8 justice from Prairie View A&M University in 2010; she furthered her  
9 education by obtaining a juris doctor degree from South Texas  
10 College of Law in 2013 and a master of legal studies degree in oil,  
11 gas, and energy resources from the University of Oklahoma in 2020;

13        WHEREAS, At the time of her passing, Mrs. Vicknair was  
14 working as a construction attorney with the Chapman Firm in Austin,  
15 where she was recognized as a promising young professional; she was  
16 active in several industry organizations, including the Austin  
17 Young Lawyers Association, the Austin Bar Association, and various  
18 sections of the State Bar of Texas; and

19        WHEREAS, A devoted wife and mother, Mrs. Vicknair enjoyed the  
20 love and support of her husband, Kevin Vicknair, and their three  
21 children, Kenzi, Kairo, and Kya; in her leisure time, she enjoyed  
22 traveling and attending concerts and sporting events; she and her  
23 husband set an inspiring example of charitable involvement for  
24 their children by organizing fundraisers and food drives and taking

1 part in other community outreach activities, and after her son was  
2 diagnosed with sickle cell anemia in 2020, she dedicated herself to  
3 promoting awareness of the disease; and

4 WHEREAS, During her years on this earth, Lyndsey Vicknair  
5 demonstrated a passion for life and a steadfast commitment to the  
6 causes in which she believed, and those who were fortunate enough to  
7 know her will never forget the love and friendship that she shared  
8 with them; now, therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 89th Texas  
10 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Lyndsey Captain  
11 Vicknair and extend heartfelt condolences to her family: to her  
12 husband, Kevin Vicknair; to her children, Kenzi, Kairo, and Kya; to  
13 her sister, Laura-Marie Captain; to her cousins; and to her many  
14 other relatives and friends; and, be it further
