5 of the Laredo Convention and Visitors Bureau; he is tasked with  
6 developing and implementing programs that promote the city around  
7 the world; he also facilitates global initiatives, serves as a  
8 diplomatic liaison, supports protocol and sub-diplomacy  
9 activities, and writes reports; in 2024, he earned a course  
10 certificate in global diplomacy from the University of London; and

11        WHEREAS, Mr. Ollervides served as assistant to the mayor of  
12 Laredo from 2018 to 2024; in that role, he was responsible for  
13 managing the mayor's schedule and correspondence, accompanying him  
14 at public events and on international trips, and acting as his  
15 advisor, translator, and interpreter; he also provided counsel on  
16 U.S.-Mexico relations; from 2007 to 2018, he worked as an  
17 audiovisual technical assistant for Laredo's Public Access Center,  
18 producing public service announcements, assisting in script  
19 creation and translation, and supervising television programming;

22 Ollervides has greatly benefited the City of Laredo, and his  
23 contributions have earned the lasting respect and appreciation of  
24 his colleagues and his fellow citizens; now, therefore, be it
