1 WHEREAS, The University of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston
2 has been named a 2025 High Performing Hospital for Maternity Care by
3 *U.S. News & World Report*; and

4 WHEREAS, Since 2021, *U.S. News & World Report* has published
5 an annual ranking of hospitals that provide labor and delivery
6 services; the ranking is designed to assist expectant parents in
7 making informed decisions about where to receive maternity care in
8 consultation with their prenatal care team; and

9 WHEREAS, UTMB earned a High Performing designation by
10 *U.S. News* based on its scores in several categories, including care
11 provided in cases involving severe unexpected newborn
12 complications, birthing-friendly practices, and transparency in
13 reporting on racial and ethnic disparities in birth outcomes; it
14 was among more than 800 hospitals from across the United States that
15 were evaluated as part of this year's study; and

16 WHEREAS, This prestigious national designation is a
17 testament to The University of Texas Medical Branch's commitment to
18 upholding the highest standards of practice for the women and
19 infants entrusted to its care, and the Galveston community is
20 indeed fortunate to be home to such a first-rate health care
21 provider; now, therefore, be it
