11 WHEREAS, In the course of a successful career in education, 12 Mrs. Stewart taught art in Fort Worth, Austin, and Henderson and served as an art advisor in the Brazosport Independent School 13 14 District; she further pursued her passion for art by painting backdrops for The Little Theater of Brazosport and vessels of all 15 16 sorts at the Freeport docks; a dedicated environmentalist, she gave generously of her time and talents to the Texas Environmental 17 Coalition, the Cradle of Texas Conservancy, and the Dow Chemical 18 Community Advisory Panel, and she held seats on the Galveston Bay 19 Council and the National Advisory Committee on Oceans 20 and 21 Atmosphere; moreover, she played a vital role in the creation of the Galveston Bay Foundation and the Galveston Bay Estuary Program, and 22 23 she helped to shape environmental legislative policy and to organize some of the first coordinated beach cleanup efforts on the 24
