The 12 Franklin Center for Government and Public Integrity and Jon Cassidy in 2023; an accomplished appellate lawyer, she authored hundreds of 13 14 briefs and argued more than 40 appeals over the course of her tenure, including numerous cases before the Supreme Court of the 15 16 United States, the en banc U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit, and the Texas Supreme Court; and 17 18 WHEREAS, Ms. Pettit holds a bachelor's degree in history from the College of William and Mary, and she graduated summa cum laude 19 20 both from there and from the University of Virginia School of Law; 21 she embarked on her legal career as a clerk for the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit, and she went on to practice at a 22 23 large law firm in New York for two years and then at a litigation boutique in Washington, D.C., for five years, handling commercial 24
