2 her life on October 26, 2024, when she became a naturalized citizen
3 of the United States of America; and

4 WHEREAS, "Trish" Thompson arrived in the U.S. from Canada as
5 an employee of the Dow Chemical Company in 2006, and she soon fell
6 in love with Texas and especially Brazoria County; within a few
7 weeks, she had become enamored with the natural beauty and sense of
8 community found on the Texas coast, and she went on to develop many
9 close friendships among her new neighbors; and

10 WHEREAS, While in Texas, she met her future husband, Jeffery
11 Thompson; the pair exchanged wedding vows in 2012, and she has
12 happily embraced her role as a stepmother to his two daughters; in
13 2018, she accepted a position with MEGlobal, which allowed her to
14 support the company's operations in both Canada and the United
15 States, her adopted country; and

16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thompson began the process of applying for U.S.
17 citizenship in 2023 and completed her civics test on September 20,
18 2024, just five days before her birthday; she became a naturalized
19 citizen on October 26 of that year, and she is being recognized for
20 this achievement on the occasion of Brazoria County Day at the State
21 Capitol on February 25, 2025; and

23 new life for herself as an American citizen and a valued member of
24 the Brazoria County community, and it is a pleasure to join in
