R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, School boards play a crucial role in meeting the  
2 diverse educational needs of the youth in their districts, and the  
3 observance of School Board Recognition Month in January 2025  
4 provides a fitting opportunity to honor Suzanne Kenoyer for her  
5 more than three decades of outstanding contributions to the Judson

8 Baptist University, Ms. Kenoyer was initially employed with Judson

14 members and 22,500 students on 32 campuses; her responsibilities

17 of creating an optimal learning environment for all pupils;  
18 moreover, this distinguished public servant has built lasting  
19 connections with district employees and families, fostering a deep  
20 appreciation for the spirit of the Judson ISD community; and

21           WHEREAS, Suzanne Kenoyer has made a meaningful difference in  
22 the lives of countless young Texans through her work in the Judson  
23 Independent School District, and she may indeed take great pride in  
24 her exceptional record of achievement; now, therefore, be it
