RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Residents of Wise County are visiting Austin on
- 2 February 4, 2025, to celebrate Wise County Day at the State Capitol;
- 3 and
- WHEREAS, Located in the northwestern part of the state, Wise
- 5 County was established on January 23, 1856; the county was carved
- 6 out of Cooke County by legislative act and named in honor of Henry
- 7 A. Wise, a U.S. congressman from Virginia who had supported the
- 8 annexation of Texas; at the same time as it created Wise County, the
- 9 legislature decreed that its county seat be established within five
- 10 miles of the county's center, and two years later that new community
- 11 became known as Decatur, after the naval hero Stephen Decatur; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The eastern fork of the Chisholm Trail passed near
- 13 Decatur during the latter half of the 19th century, and the town
- 14 prospered as a shipping point and market for local farmers; today,
- 15 it is a center for natural gas production, specialty carbon and
- 16 graphite manufacturing, and health care, as well as marketing and
- 17 processing for area agribusiness; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Decatur is also home to some of the best
- 19 professional rodeo cowboys and bull riders in the world; the many
- 20 champions who have lived or trained in the community include one of
- 21 the most decorated rodeo cowboys of all time, Trevor Brazile, as
- 22 well as Tuf Cooper and Texas Rodeo Hall of Famer Roy Cooper, both of
- 23 the famed Cooper family; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Visitors to Wise County are drawn by such historic

- 1 attractions as the Waggoner Mansion, the Wise County Veterans Park,
- 2 and the pink granite Wise County Courthouse, which was completed in
- 3 1896; the county also offers a variety of recreational
- 4 opportunities at Lake Bridgeport, Eagle Mountain Lake, and the
- 5 Caddo-Lyndon B. Johnson National Grasslands; in addition, area
- 6 residents commemorate their heritage with the annual Butterfield
- 7 Stage Days Festival in May, the Wise County Old Settlers Reunion in
- 8 July, and the Chisholm Trail Days and Western Heritage Festival in
- 9 August; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Celebrating their history as they embrace the
- 11 opportunities of the future, the citizens of Wise County take great
- 12 pride in their community, and it is indeed fitting to honor their
- 13 unique contributions to the story of the Lone Star State; now,
- 14 therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 89th Texas
- 16 Legislature hereby recognize February 4, 2025, as Wise County Day
- 17 at the State Capitol and extend a warm welcome to the visiting
- 18 delegation.
