1 WHEREAS, Shelley Smith, the longtime chief executive officer
2 of West Texas Centers in Big Spring, retired on July 12, 2024, after
3 40 years of dedicated service to the community mental health
4 center; and

5 WHEREAS, Ms. Smith accepted the role of CEO in May 1996;
6 under her guidance, the center experienced significant growth, and
7 it continues to be a major regional provider of services related to
8 mental health and intellectual and developmental disabilities,
9 including an early childhood intervention program; and

10 WHEREAS, Today, West Texas Centers serves a 23-county area,
11 employs nearly 325 people, and treats more than 2,000 patients and
12 their families every month at 35 locations; throughout her tenure
13 as CEO, Ms. Smith kept the well-being of the organization's clients
14 at the forefront of her decision-making, and she set an inspiring
15 example for staff through her exemplary work ethic and unwavering
16 compassion; and

17 WHEREAS, Over the past four decades, Shelley Smith made a
18 meaningful difference in the lives of the individuals and families
19 served by West Texas Centers, and she may indeed reflect with pride
20 on her contributions as she embarks on a well-deserved retirement;
